

Dear Members and Friends:

June is upon us and soon the true summer season will begin. With the high temperatures and long dry period we've had, our streams already looked like August. Thankfully we've had some rains to give the fields and forests a good drink and to elevate those water levels. I certainly hope that pattern will continue.

I cordially invite everyone to join us at the Brodhead TU #289 Picnic on Saturday, June 13, 2015 at the ForEvergreen Preserve in Analomink, PA. We'll supply the tables, the main courses, water and soda, and you can supply your chair and a side dish or a dessert. We look forward to having a good time in a very scenic spot along our beloved Brodhead Creek. I'm sure the eaglets won't mind the company! It's an informal affair so don't be shy.

If you've been following the issue of the Clean Water Act, you know that the EPA did, indeed, finalize the "Water of the US Rule", clarifying protection to headwater and ephemeral streams and wetlands. These headwaters serve as vital collectors and buffers to those areas downstream. I expect significant opposition to the passage of this rule, most probably within the court system. I ask that, as the issue moves forward, you contact you legislators to let them know your position. Even if you know they are against it, it is important they understand that cool, clean water is a limiting resource factor for human, animal, and plant survival and intact

headwaters help keep our downstream areas clean.

I want to thank the seven members who assisted the National Park Service with their Learn to Fish Program on Memorial Day Sunday. Seven of us donned our TU shirts and hats (We looked pretty good, by the way!) and assisted the Park staff and interns in introducing casting, knot tying, ethical fishing, life vest safety and other topics to youngsters at Hidden Lake. It was a lot of fun and I look forward to helping next year.

I also want to thank those eight members who assisted with the Dunkelberger's Fly-Fishing event. You went out of your way to help when it was need and, again, we were the people out there engaging people in our sport. I'm sure that the hours we invested yielded large dividends for the attendees.

Our May newsletter had multiple updates and there is not much to follow up with other than reminders that our Trout In The Classroom brook trout release will be very soon. I will contact the teacher to get a date and time and I will let you know.

I have received several inquiries from fisherman outside our area who want to fish the Brodhead. One of their concerns is access. This, of course, has been one of our concerns for a long time. Thankfully, I have been able to give directions to Brodhead Park, Pinebrook Park, and ForEvergreen Preserve and every time I send some maps and information I am thankful to groups like Stroud Township, Brodhead Watershed Association, Pocono Heritage Land Trust, and yes, Brodhead TU, for working to make the Brodhead available to the general public and to have places to eat, relax, and enjoy some fishing. There are many places where citizens don't enjoy such benefits. Remember to thank the membership of these organization when you can.

Our Pocono Creek restoration project continues to be on schedule and Eric Baird, Don Baylor, Don Miller, and I met with our contractor to map out some final details for our mid-summer project. The earliest work can begin is June 15 but we're aiming sometime mid-summer. Stream levels will be one determining factor as to when we set a date. After locating the rocks we will use, I can assure you I am dwarfed by some of the boulders. These will be placed along the banks and in the stream to provide cover, increase depth and velocity, and provide habitat for trout and other water dwelling creatures. If you've ever fished this stream with some regularity, you know that if there is any decent depth in the water with a current seam, you'll probably find a wild brown or even a native brookie. We truly believe this project will have a positive impact on the fishery on this parcel of land between the former Northampton Community College (who is supplying the boulders) and Route 611.

I hope to see you at the picnic or at the June 28th event at ForEvergreen or both!
