For the past few months, I've been writing about how spring is almost here. Well maybe, just maybe, we'll actually see some spring-like weather. I certainly hope so because the snow, as much as I like it, is getting old!

Thank you to all who participated and supported us in some way before, during, or after our 20th Annual Spring Banquet. The Chapter netted \$4,400 that will go a long way in funding our various habitat improvement projects and our educational outreach activities. Great job everyone!

If you've look at our calendar, it is an extremely busy month. Little did we know that our schedule would have some additional clean-up activities added to it. The plastic pellet or "nurdle" spill into Sand Spring Run has certainly stirred us into action and our cleanup along the Learn Preserve and PHLT tract off Old Mill Road in Tannersville is set for the afternoon of Sunday, April 15 (1—4 PM).

We're expecting action on two PA legislative bills early this month. The first is SB 935 which, if passed, would set an 8 year term limit for the Executive Director of the PA Fish and Boat Commission. We are opposed to that legislation. The other bill, SB30, may be stalled in the House Game and Fisheries Committee. We are in favor of this bill as it would allow the PFBC to raise licensing fees to offset costs associated with running the organization.

I would be remiss if I didn't mention that the 2018 Trout Season Opener is Saturday, April 14 at 8 AM. If you can't wait that long, head over to Glenbrook Park and fish the Keystone Select Delayed Harvest Area and enjoy the possibility of landing a whopper.

And of course, Earth Day is April 21, 2018 and we'll see you at NCC-Monroe.

Pocono Creek Cleanup

On Saturday, March 31, a truck loaded with approximately 29,000 pounds of plastic pellets—nurdles— careened over an embankment on I-80 east, spilling the blue bits along and into Sand Spring Run. The run is a prime tributary of Pocono Creek and the current carried an unknown quantity of these nurdles downstream for miles. In an effort to clean up some of this mess, we've organized a cleanup for Sunday afternoon, April 15, 2018. We'll meet at the former NCC building in Tannersville and spread out to cover as much of the creek banks in the Learn Preserve and PHLT land as possible.

Because these particles float, failure to remove them from the stream and stream banks now will result in them moving downstream or inland every time the water rises. Whereas they are plastic, they will remain as a pollutant for a very longs time. This removal work will not be easy but through the combined efforts of many, we are hopeful to complete the task. If you think you can help, come on out. See the flyer on page 6 for details and, as the old saying goes, we all live downstream!

Stalking the Invasive Nurdle

A nurdle is a very small pellet of plastic that serves as raw material in the manufacture of plastic products.

Unfortunately on March 31, 2018 a truck carrying 29,000 pounds of nurdles capsized off of Route 80 and spilled a portion of its content into the Pocono Creek Watershed. Thanks to the herculean efforts of Schlier's Towing the bulk of the nurdles were removed at the source. Now we are going to try and capture as many of the escapees as possible. The clean-up will take place the George and Olive Learn Preserve, the Pocono Heritage Land Trust Pocono Creek Preserve and the TLC Park.

We will be meeting at the former Northampton Community College site on Old Mill Road. Please bring aquarium nets, pool skimmers, dust pans, flat bladed

shovels, rechargeable (dust buster) vacuums, and buckets. The event is rain or shine so dress for the elements and be prepared to get into the creek. Bring a reusable water bottle and insect repellent. For more information contact brodheadchapter@gmail.com
