

Dear Members and Friends:

I hope that as we close one year and begin another you can look back with fond memories of your time with family, friends, and colleagues. As President of the Brodhead Chapter of Trout Unlimited, when I reflect on the past year I can honestly say I am proud to be part of such a dynamic organization. This pride is borne of the success of our members in meeting the varied foci of our mission as a Chapter.

We continued our long-standing outreach with youth via support of the Knights of Columbus and Stroud Township Fishing Derby, Monroe County Youth Field Day, the Monroe County Conservation Camp, and Rivers Conservation Camp. On the communication side we updated our web site for even greater ease of use by members and non-members. (Many thanks to Will Daskal and Russ Thrall for seeing this project through to completion. It is greatly appreciated.) Rumors of an impending Twitter account for even quicker blasts of information are true! Stay tuned.

We utilized email and Action Alerts several times in order to ensure our members and friends were aware and educated about various legislative initiatives that would affect our coldwater resources. We encouraged and guided members in making their voices heard at the local, state, and national levels and are excited by the members' responses. The effects these communications have made and will continue to

make will be a vital part of the democratic process as we move forward into the new year.

Conservation efforts included planning for stream improvement on the former Learn property track along Pocono Creek, Embrace-A-Stream (EAS) grant completion for signage along the Cranberry and other streams, riparian tree planting with the Boy Scouts along Tobyhanna Creek, working cooperatively with the Brodhead Watershed Association and Pocono Heritage Land Trust, and the submission for another EAS grant for 2015. We began sharing educational programs with neighboring TU Chapters Forks of the Delaware, Monocacy, Hokendaqua, and Little Lehigh.

The Chapter reached out to educate and assist our community by having members help with various public events, by incorporating Casting for Recovery into our meeting schedule and by working with wounded veteran's. We instructed fly-fishing workshops at Kettle Creek and at Pocono Environmental Education Centers. Our sponsorship of Trout in the Classroom at Swiftwater Intermediate School resulted in a vital and unique education experience for the students;

As we head into the new year, we will continue to focus on all these areas that are so vital to the success of our organization. Through your efforts, your time, and your talents, our Brodhead Chapter will truly make a difference. I close by sharing with you a portion of Alfred Lord Tennyson's "The Brook," one of my favorite poems.

I wind about, and in and out, With here a blossom sailing And here and there a lusty trout, and here and there a grayling.
